Grammar: Someone/Anyone/No One

“Where” is used to ask questions about the location or place.

“Where is” for singular nouns: **Where is** the accident?

“Where are” for plural nouns: **Where are** the firefighters?

“Where are” is also used with “you” plural nouns: **Where are** you?

Remember that all questions end with a question mark (?).
