### Grammar: Someone/Anyone/No One

**“Where”** is used to ask questions about the location or place.

*“Where is”* for singular nouns: **Where is** the accident?

*“Where are”* for plural nouns: **Where are** the firefighters?

*“Where are”* is also used with “you” plural nouns: **Where are** you?

**Remember that all questions end with a question mark (?).**
