	Step 1 Warm Up (15 minutes)
(*the fac organ p • V • A • A	The names of our Organs and what are their purposes: cilitator can refer to teacher notes on organs at any time to better understand purposes) Write the word <i>Organs</i> on the board and ask the class what it means. Ask them if they can name any organs – write them on the board. Ask them if they know what these organs do – write any answers on the board. Explain today you will discuss organs in our bodies
	Step 2 Work out (60 minutes)
 H H b H m C fr d 	In a gabout Organs: I and out the Organ Flashcards and ask the Ps if they can identify what they are. I and out the Organ picture boxes and have the Ps match the organs from the picture oxes with the flashcards. I and out the Organ definitions and have the Ps in groups read what organs do and hatch the definitions with the picture boxes and the flashcards. Come back as a group. Hand out the Organ Diagram page (there are two to chose rom – you can chose one or use both) and on the board list the organs and what they o. Make it into a group discussion. I and out the Draw and Label the Organs and have the Ps draw where the organs go.
