Unit: Health Home Care Services in Manitoba

Objective

Objective – Ps will listen to, read and be able to talk about Home Care Services in Manitoba and the process for accessing it. Ps will answer Qs about Home Care and demonstrate knowledge gained through their answers.

Materials

- FACILITATOR RESOURCE 1 MB Seniors Guide 2015-16
- FACILITATOR RESOURCE 2- Your Guide to Home Care Services in MB
- LARGE PICTURE FLASHCARDS of Home Care Services
- HANDOUT How to access Home Care
- WORKSHEET Home Care Services Available
- JIGSAW 1 Eligibility and Case Coordination
- JIGSAW 2 Home Care Services available to you (could be used in a second class)

Step 1 Warm Up (15 minutes)

What is a Home Care?

- Show the large picture flashcard of the person helping someone into bed what is happening here?
- Show the large picture flashcard of the person helping someone bathing what is happening here?
- Show the large picture flashcard of the person pouring tea what is happening here?

Step 2 Work out (30 minutes)

Jigsaw 1: Eligibility and Case Coordination

Put the Ps into 3 groups. Hand out a different section of the Jigsaw accordingly to groups 1,2 and 3. In their groups have them read and study together and practice retelling in their own words.

When they feel confident to retell the information chose one person to move from each group to another group and "teach" their new group about what they learned with their part of the jigsaw (chose the higher level Ps to do this activity)

Move the Ps around again until all parts of the jigsaw have been shared and each group has heard the information from the other 2 groups.

INTERMEDIATE

Step 3 Cool Down (15 minutes)

Review:

 Hand out a full version of "Eligibility and Case Coordination" to everyone. Ask them specific Qs based on the information on the sheet.

Option for a 2nd Class (or this class if you have time)

Jigsaw 2: Home Care Services available to you.

It is good for the Ps to understand that they may not be eligible for some services, and it is the case co-ordinator who makes these decisions in consultation with them and their family. Also, sometimes they may have to pay for a service (i.e. a service may be "Covered", i.e. free, or "NOT Covered", or partly covered. This jigsaw provides them this information.

Follow the directions for Jigsaw 1.

Review:

- Hand out a full version of "Home Care Services available to you" to everyone. Ask them
 specific Qs based on the information on the sheet.
- Go around the room and ask them to name a service. Write each service on the board and ask them if they are Covered or Not Covered.

NOTE: If you would like to use realia, the information for these two jigsaws is drawn from the **FACILITATOR RESOURCE 2 – Your Guide to Home Care Services in MB.**

- Page 1& 2 covers Eligibility and Case Coordination

Page 3 covers Home Care Services available to you (without the "Covered/Not Covered" information).
