Unit: Staying Safe in a Winnipeg Winter

Objective

Ps will practice vocabulary for proper winter clothing.

Ps will learn about ways to stay safe during winter and practice the topic vocabulary.

Materials

- · Review flash Review flashcard pictures of large winter flashcards
- Mini temperature flashcards.
- winter clothing mini flashcards
- summer clothing mini flashcards
- dangerous flashcards
- safety flashcards
- vitamin D mini flashcards
- exercise mini flashcards
- calcium mini flashcards
- the lonely lady
- flashcard of the family
- matching word flashcards

Step 1 Warm Up (15 minutes)

Introduce the topic of winter:

- Hold up a picture of winter. What is this? Write the word winter on board.
- Ask "What is the temperature in Winnipeg in the winter?" Write their answer(s) on the board.
- Hand out the **temperature flashcards**. What is **cold** and what is **very cold**? Make sure they understand the difference between cold (- 5C) and very cold (-25C, or worse -35C) Have them in pairs put the cards into 2 piles, cold and very cold.
- Review all the vocabulary with them for the winter clothing. Have them name their own clothing. (Hat, scarf, mitts etc.)

Step 2 Work out (30 minutes)

Clothing for Winnipeg:

- Ask "What kind of clothing do you wear in the winter?" List their answers on the board.
- Hand out the winter clothing mini flashcards and ask them to name them. Go over all the
 - flashcards one by one . Add any new names on the board. Why is it important to wear this type of clothing?
- Hand out the **summer clothing mini flashcards**. Ask them if they should wear that in the winter. Why not?
- Review all the vocabulary with them for the winter clothing. Have them name their own clothing. (Hat, scarf, mitts etc.)



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FOUNDATION

Safety in the Winter:

- Write the word dangerous on one side of the board and the word safe on the other side
 of the board. Get out the winter safety large flashcards. Start talking about them and
 putting them on the appropriate side of the board with tape. As you name them put the
 matching word flashcards underneath.
- Explain each one in very simple language and gestures.
- Have them repeat with you and repeat to one another.

Step 3 Cool Down (15 minutes)

Review the winter safety facts:

- Take down the flashcards from the board and hand one to each P. Have them come up and put it under the correct title – dangerous or safe.
- Hand out a clothing mini flashcard to each P and have them name them to you.
