Fatigue, Weakness	<u>Sometimes</u>	<u>Usually;</u> can last 2 to 3 weeks
Extreme Exhaustion	<u>Never</u>	<u>Usually</u> ; at the beginning of the illness
Stuffy Nose	Common	<u>Sometimes</u>
Sneezing	<u>Usually</u>	Sometimes
Sore Throat	Common	<u>Sometimes</u>
Chest Discomfort, Cough	Mild to moderate; hacking cough	Common; can become severe
Complications	Sinus congestion; middle ear	Sinusitis, bronchitis, ear infection, pneumonia; can
