

Know How To Call 911 Grammar: Someone/Anyone/No One

"Anyone" is used to ask questions. It means one person or another.		
Is <u>anyone</u> hurt?		
"Someone" means one person. The speaker doesn't say the person's name. It is used with affirmative statements and to answer questions.		
Yes, <u>someone</u> is hurt.		
"No one" is used to answer questions with negative statements. It means no person.		
No, <u>no one</u> is hurt.
