

Unit: Community – Documents
Objective
Ps will identify important documents they will need in their lives in Winnipeg.
Materials
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large flashcards of documents (Permanent Resident, Social Insurance and MB Health card) • Ps own documents (Permanent Resident, Social Insurance and MB Health card)
Step 1 Warm Up (5 minutes)
<p>Important Documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask someone in the class “What is this?” Hold up a large flashcard of the Permanent Resident card. Do they know what it is? Put the words on the board. • Repeat this with the SIN and MB Health Flashcards.
Step 2 Work out (15 minutes)
<p>Learning about their own documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask the students to get out their own Permanent Resident cards. (They should have been instructed the previous class to bring them to school.) • Discuss what they see on the card. • Explain that this is a very important document but it should be kept at home and not in their wallets or purses. • Have them get out their SIN cards. Discuss what they see on the card. Explain it is for all people in Canada but very private. This card does not need to be carried around with them either. • Have them get out their MB Health cards and discuss what they see. Explain that to go to a doctor or hospital they need their card. Explain they should <u>always</u> carry it with them.
Step 3 Cool Down (5 minutes)
<p>Check their progress:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go back to the board and point to each document and ask “what is this?” • Ask the Ps to “Show me your MB health card.” See if they can hold up the correct one. Repeat several times with the different documents.
