Total Indigenous population 1,673,785 (1.67 Million)

First Nation population 977,230

- There are more than 634 First Nation communities in Canada
- More than 50 Nations and more than 70 Indigenous languages.

About 45% of First Nations live on Reserves, the balance live in urban centres.

Inuit population 65,025

- In 53 Communities across the Arctic

Métis population 587,545

- Most live in urban centres across Canada. Winnipeg has the highest number.

- Cree
- Dene
- Ojibwe
- Dakota
- Oji-Cree
