-	Ask Qs about how to protect yourself from CRA and IRCC Immigration scams
-	After they have completed the Jigsaws, give them handout so they have the phone numbers etc.
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When these homogeneous groups have mastered the material the participants regroup into heterogeneous groups to present material and complete a task.

So the groups of 4 in the first stage would look like this:
