
1. Flattening the Curve




Number of cases - number of people diagnosed with COVID-19

Protective measures - things we do to keep from spreading and catching COVID-19

- Red area no protective measures means lots of cases all at once
- Blue area same number of cases spread out over more time

Healthcare System capacity - the ability for hospitals and health professionals to care for sick people. They have to have enough staff, hospital beds, PPE and equipment like ventilators

2. Slowing the growth of the COVID-19 pandemic



So far, Manitoba (MB) has done a great job of flattening the curve and slowing the growth. However we must keep doing what we're doing until there's no more COVID-19 (not likely) or a vaccine (which can take 18-24 months).
